

El'dad Supported Cluster Program

SCP Overview

The objective of the Supported Cluster Program (SCP) is to assist participants with their long-term goal of fewer supports and greater independence. We provide opportunities for independence and learning life skills while having supports that can be accessed as needed. KHP (Klassen House Program) is an alcohol and drug-free building located at the Ranch where participants have access to SIL supports and on-site supports during evening hours. In addition to KHP, El'dad has access to a 3-suite building where 24/7 supports are available to tenants as needed, as well as a 4-suite building that provides opportunities for independence with access to SIL supports and on-site supports during the late evenings.

Eligibility Requirements

- On-site at the Ranch: Male, over 18
- Off-site cluster suites in the community: Female or Male, over 18
- Must meet eligibility requirements for the Community Living disABILITY Services Program through Family Services. Eligibility for participation is based on established needs for the individual, resources available, further assessment, and participation in supports. It should also be noted that eligibility for Community Living disABILITY Services does not immediately guarantee attendance/placement in any of El'dad's programs.
- Potential participants must meet the criteria for living independently with supports.

Referrals

- Referrals must be made through a Community Living disABILITY Services Community Service Worker.
- Potential participants are encouraged to visit the program first.
- Opportunity to see the residence, identify potential services, and ask any questions.
- Part of residing within the Supported Cluster Program is an agreement to abide by the guidelines of El'dad and engage in supports.

Locations

- KHP is located on an 18-acre farm site about 12 km from Steinbach.
 - On-site three-bedroom home with shared living spaces
- First Street is in the city of Steinbach.
 - Two individual suites
 - One supported/crisis suite

- Cluster House is in the city of Steinbach.
 - Three individual suites
 - One support/ crisis suite
- All El'dad programs are situated on Treaty 1 Territory.

Supports

- In the Supported Cluster Program there is a team of Direct Support Workers who are available to assist with goals, life skills, and community involvement.
- Participants are supported both individually and by shared supports.
- All participants are encouraged to engage in supports to achieve goals through person-centered and strength-based planning.
- Supporting participants with building and maintaining positive relationships in the community. Assisting with facilitating connections based on common interests, hobbies, and recreational activities.

Additional El'dad Supports Available

- Event nights
 - Access to weekly events
 - Games Night, Movie Nights, Music Nights, Sports Nights
- Life Skills Development Centre
 - The Life Skills Development Centre is an El'dad site located in Mitchell and is available to participants at El'dad pending referral. This is determined during the planning process with CSWs.
- Day Program
 - The Day Program, which focuses on developing work skills, is located at the Ranch and is available to participants at El'dad pending referral. This is determined during the planning process with CSWs.
